SVdP SMG Conference assists those who have fallen upon times of hardship and personal crisis. We schedule home visits of two members to individuals and families that need necessities such as food, utility, and rental payments.

The role of the Vincentian is to provide financial assistance and be loving, supportive, and compassionate. It is through loving those in need that we meet Christ.

Our Conference is volunteer-based, and 100% of the donations received go to helping those in urgent need. We serve four zip codes in Arlington, TX: 76010, 76011, 76012, and 76013.

Who and how we help - Guidelines

As Vincentians, we have received the call to help and assist those in need. We are stewards of your financial gifts and contributions. We Pray to The Holy Spirit to be good administrators and to follow His guidance with all our decisions to help and assist our friends and neighbors.

When funds are available, we offer financial assistance to pay for rent, utilities, a limited amount for car repairs, and household storage (exceptions considered). We limit our help to each family to once per calendar year. We do not require filling up paperwork. We ask for a form of identification during the home visit. If the request is for rent, we need to see a copy of the lease agreement and obtain a copy of the Landlord's W-9, as mandated by the I.R.S. We require copies of the utility bills, or any other expense requested. We pay the service providers and will never hand money to our neighbors. We provide financial support to those families that have the means to support themselves in the months to come. We help those trying and showing interest in getting ahead of their present situation. We should always be considered the first step to self-sufficiency. We are not to be guilty of enabling, that is, aiding those not trying to help themselves.

We understand we are a bridge to a temporary and immediate solution, not a long-term assistance program. Please see our **local resources tab to find long-term solution providers**. All home visit reports get presented in our weekly scheduled meetings, and our members vote who to help based on the information gathered, the current balance in our bank account, and the number of pending cases for that week. We ask all our families requesting assistance to Pray for us so that we can provide them with the proper resolution to their current needs.
