



The Art Conspiracy Summer Arts Program 2019

In cooperation with the Sheridan School District, we will hold our 20th summer arts program in Sheridan. It is open to students aged 9-high school from Yamhill/Polk Counties. Preference will be given to returning students and new students from Amity, Sheridan, Willamina, and Grande Ronde who register prior to June 1.

The summer arts program consists of eight days of 2 ½ hour morning and afternoon classes. The classes will be held Monday-Thursday starting June 17th. There are no classes on Fridays. On Friday, June 21st, there will be an optional field trip. On Friday, June 28th, starting at 5:30pm, there will be a performance and art exhibition.

Courses are taught by working artists and educators. Classes are limited to 10 students to maximize learning. Classes with low enrollment may be canceled. Sheridan Willamina High School in Sheridan, OR. Bussing will be provided to and from Amity and Willamina to Sheridan.

This program is funded through grants, tuition, and private donations from local individuals and businesses. We welcome your support.

Lunches

Through the Summer Lunch Program free lunches will be made available to Summer Arts Program participants. For student safety, we ask that all students remain on campus for lunch.

Registration

Registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis with priority being given to returning students and students from Amity, Sheridan, Willamina, and Grand Ronde. Classes fill quickly and early registration is encouraged. A deposit of \$25 is due with registration. Balance is due by the first day of classes. No tuition refunds will be given after June 10. Students may register from 8:30-9am on June 17th as space allows with an additional \$25 late registration fee. Attendance

Students are expected to attend all classes and the final Friday, June 28th Performance and Art Exhibition. Due to the nature and quality of the classes we offer, missed days cause significant disruption to class content and impact all attendees--including the student missing classes. This disruption makes it difficult for our instructors to keep everyone in sync for the class collaborative projects. Therefore, partial attendance is strongly discouraged.

Student Conduct

Students should be courteous and respectful to teachers, staff, and fellow students. Students who are disruptive to the program may be asked to leave and may jeopardize future enrollment. Financial aid students who are disruptive will not be allowed to enroll the following year.

Please wear loose, comfortable clothing that can be discarded without regret, as some classes get very messy. Shorts, jeans, and t-shirts are advised.
