Requirements:

- * A desire to make our community stronger and safer.

- * Must be 18 years or older—there is no upper limit.

- * Not all volunteers are firefighters. We need many skills to keep the department going and the engines rolling.

What's the process?

- * All prospective firefighters begin with an Academy of 10 to 11 training sessions. Each session is about 2 hours. The last session is an all day event.
- * All firefighters participate in weekly trainings to build skills and teamwork. Each session is approximately 2 hours. All active firefighters are expected to participate in at least half of the trainings offered each year.
- * We all have busy lives. We make an effort to be flexible and to accommodate schedules and obligations.

Benefits:

- * The Fire Department is the most critical resource in the community. Our volunteers are our most valuable neighbors.
- * Every training, every meeting, every call-out or event, is an opportunity to learn something new.
- * Interested in Emergency Medical Services? The Department will reimburse every volunteer who completes the EMT course, and any refresher classes.
- * Travel outside the community is not required, but the Fire Department has mutual aid agreements with all local fire agencies and public land management agencies. Volunteers who travel are compensated for their time and expenses.
